ArtForms, working in partnership with East Street Arts, are seeking **NINE VISUAL ARTISTS** to participate in an exciting scheme which supports professional visual artists who have an interest in developing their work in schools.

The ARTIST CAROUSEL offers artists the opportunity to collaborate with high school art teachers and to develop their skills and practice in an education setting.

### **How will the 'Artist Carousel' work?**

- Each artist will be paired with a high school art & design teacher.
- The artist will shadow a lesson in school delivered by the teacher.
- Each artist will then be supported by the teacher to:
  - Design a presentation of their portfolio for students.
  - Create a workshop linked to the curriculum and inspired by their studio practice.
- The artist will deliver their presentation and workshop in the partner school and the teacher will give feedback and further support where identified.
- The artist will deliver their presentation and workshop in two other participating schools.

*NOTE: Artists will be selected based on the range and quality of work and their commitment to the creative development of young people. Please see application form and details overleaf.*

### **Benefits:**

- Direct support to help artists apply their work, skills and experience to the school setting.
- First-hand experience of working with high school students.
- The opportunity to support creative and innovative delivery of the art & design curriculum.
- Gain an understanding of schools and the art and design curriculum.
- The chance to network with other artists and secondary teachers.
- Establishing new relationships with local schools and Education Leeds.
- Additional support and guidance from the Project Co-ordinator.

### **Summary of commitment:**

1. **Initial briefing meeting:**

Introduction to the carousel and an overview of the secondary art & design curriculum including the role of contemporary art practice in schools.
2. **Launching the Carousel:**  
**3<sup>rd</sup> November, 4.00 – 5.30pm at Patrick Studios.**  
Pairing of teachers and artists and identification of dates for delivery.
3. **Presentations and delivery of workshops by artists in partner schools:**  
**December 2010 – February 2011**  
Exact dates to be agreed between partners.
4. **FINAL review and evaluation session:**  
**March 2010 date/venue to be agreed.**

**Please NOTE:** Each artist will be awarded a single payment of **£400** as a contribution towards workshop delivery and travel expenses. ALSO: if the artist does not have an Education Leeds enhanced CRB check, ArtForms will also pay for this to be processed (value £65).
